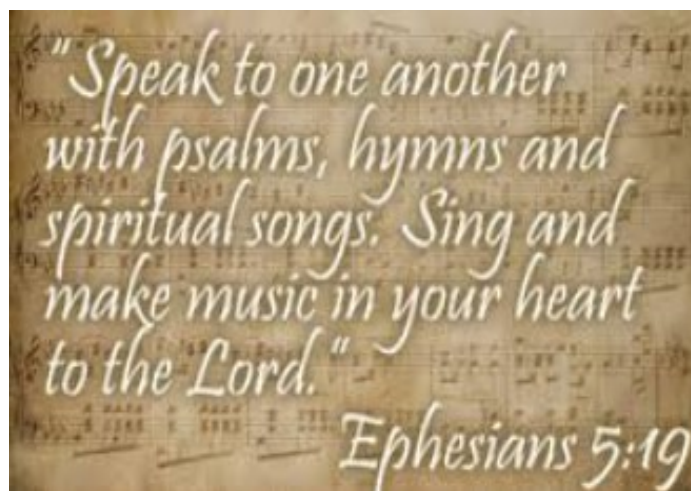
Children's Church is cancelled today so that the children can enjoy the program with their families.
